The Judicial Council's Advisory Committee on Rules has drafted a proposed set of Rules of Evidence for Virginia. The proposed rules are intended to provide an all-inclusive source to find Virginia evidence principles. The draft rules have not been approved by the Judicial Council of Virginia or the Supreme Court of Virginia. They were published in February, 2006 to invite comment from the bar, the judiciary and the public. Revised drafts have been published with the most recent draft in October, 2006. The Judicial Council is currently seeking comment on the most recent draft.

This CLE program will discuss the proposed rules, and focus on selected evidence doctrines involved in the codification.
